Cancer Council Australia will pay for registration, an economy class airfare, two weeks accommodation and living allowance (to a total of \$8,000 AUD).

## WHO SHOULD APPLY:

Any student currently enrolled in a medical course at an Australian University.

## WHAT TO SUBMIT:

An essay: **“40 years after the war on cancer - How far have we come?”**

Maximum length 2500 words.

Applicants may wish to focus on any aspect of cancer control.

The essays will be scored according to the following criteria:

- Concise and logical presentation of the argument
- Relevance to cancer care in Australia
- Relevance to medical students

1. Helping students to become familiar with cancer care in general practice;
2. Learning more about cancer-related problems in other countries; and
3. The interchange of international contacts between the future generation of medical doctors.
