If your respiratory protective equipment doesn't fit, it doesn't work

If you breathe in diesel engine exhaust, you could get lung cancer or possibly bladder cancer. It's estimated that one person every three days is diagnosed with a lung cancer caused by diesel engine exhaust exposure at work.

If you need to wear respiratory protective equipment to reduce your exposure to diesel engine exhaust, make sure it fits properly. Ask your boss or health and safety rep if you're not sure; you should be fit tested and trained in their use.
