



## Director Cancer Control Policy

### Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

#### **1. Where is the role based?**

The position is based in Sydney. Flexible working arrangements are available.

#### **2. What is the employment type?**

The position is a permanent, full-time role (35 hours per week)

#### **3. What is the salary range?**

Salary will be discussed with shortlisted candidates and is aligned with executive-level positions within Cancer Council Australia.

#### **4. Does the role require interstate travel?**

Some interstate travel may be required for national meetings, stakeholder engagement, and Federation collaboration.

#### **5. Does the role involve Board engagement?**

Yes. The role works closely with the Cancer Council Australia Board and Board Committees and holds the statutory position of Company Secretary.

#### **6. What teams does the Director oversee?**

The role directly manages:

- Cancer Control Policy team

#### **7. What is the National Cancer Control Policy?**

It is Cancer Council Australia's flagship policy document which sets the national direction and priorities across prevention, early detection, treatment and care, health systems and populations.

#### **8. Are candidates required to have experience in cancer or health?**

Familiarity with public health, behavioural change, or large-scale social marketing is highly regarded.



**9. How does the role work with the Federation?**

The role works closely with state and territory Cancer Councils, particularly senior executives to support collaboration, consistency and effectiveness of policy and advocacy outcomes across the Federation.

**10. What does success look like in the first year?**

Success will include building strong relationships with the CEO, Board and Federation members, gaining a deep understanding of the organisation, strengthening policy, advocacy and contributing to organisational strategy and performance.

**11. When will interviews be held?**

Shortlisted candidates will be notified shortly after the application closing date.
