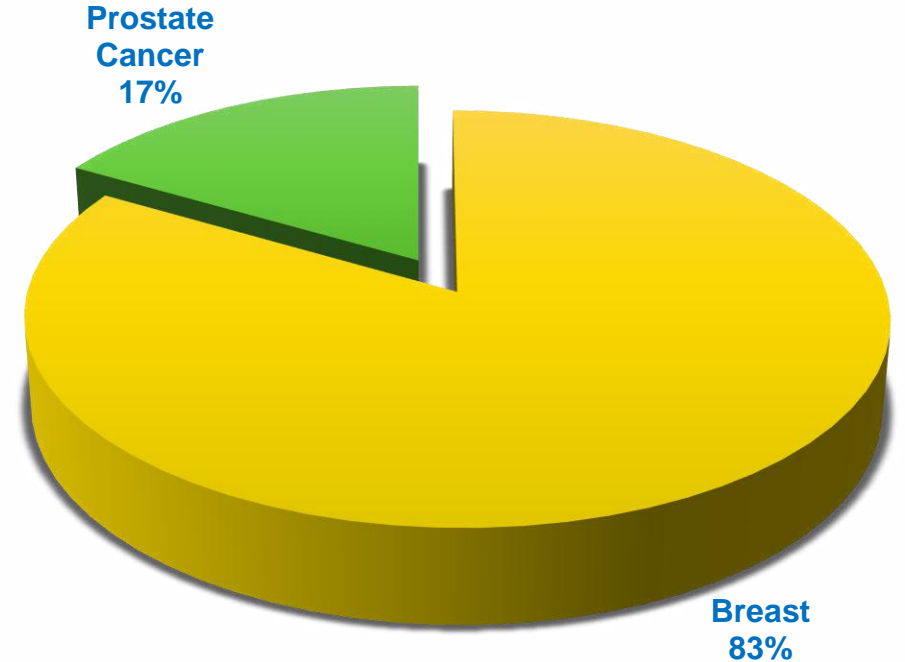
# Remote Services – Gove / Tiwi

- ❖ **SunSmart Program** - *Schools and Early Learning Centres*
- ❖ **SunSmart Workplace program** – *company workplaces and corporate partners.*
- ❖ **Cancer prevention education sessions** – *community information stalls, Expos and presentations*

  - ❖ *Top 5 cancer screening and prevention education.*
  - ❖ *Tobacco and Vaping education and cessation training.*
  - ❖ *SunSmart – skin cancer education, screening and identification and prevention education.*
